Entry Procedure	<p>The teams have to be registered by their National Volleyball Federation (NF) via e-mail, in two phases: 1) spot registration and 2) team registration (with names).</p> <p>Spot registration: NFs have to send the number of teams per category they wish to register to the organizer and to MEVZA as well. <u>Spot registration deadline: 1st of July 2022</u></p> <p>All NFs are going to receive a confirmation of the reception of the spot registration e-mail within 2-3 days. If you do not receive it, please contact the Organisers and MEVZA by the 4th of July 2022, the latest. No further spot registrations will be accepted after this date.</p> <p>Team registration: NFs have to send the names of the players and their coaches, indicating their category (age group and gender). A separate team registration form for the tournament will be sent to those NFs that registered for a spot. Competition format	<p>There will be only Main Draw and no Qualification Tournament.</p> <p>Main Draw: pool play (4 pools with 3 teams); with all teams advancing to the single elimination phase: round of 12; quarterfinals; semi-finals, bronze and gold medal matches.</p>
Teams main draw	12 teams qualify directly: - 8 team spots reserved for all MEVZA NFs, 1 team/country/category is guaranteed. - 2 additional spots for host country (AUT)

	<p>- 2 additional spots for second teams for foreign MEVZA NFs, until the Main Draw is full. If three or more foreign MEVZA NFs register second teams, these two spots will be allocated to the NFs with the highest CEV Age-Group country ranking for 2022.</p> <p>In case of remaining free spots after the spot registration in the Main Draw, these will be filled by host country teams.</p> <p>U20: In case of remaining free spots after the spot registration in the Main Draw, these will be filled by Wildcards for non-MEVZA teams.</p>

Sports equipment - jerseys	Obligation for participants / National Volleyball Federation of participants
Travel Costs	<p>Each team bears its own return travel expenses to the official competition venue. The Organizer must provide the teams with transportation from the official accommodation to the venue in case it is not in walking distance.</p>
Food & Lodging:	<p>Unique fee: € 70.- per day (incl. full board) per person.</p> <p>Each National Volleyball Federation (NF) shall pay 35 EUR of the “unique fee” per competition days (3 competition days/category) directly to the Austrian Volleyball Federation for each member of its delegation (max. 2.5 persons per team, max. 2 teams per category). MEVZA will cover the remaining 35 EUR, paid directly to the organizer (max. 2.5 persons per team, max 2 teams per category). Additional teams and delegation members and/or additional nights of accommodation requested have to be paid completely by the teams to the organizer.</p> <p>Please note that the “unique fee” include all costs related to the organization of the tournament, therefore it must be paid for all participating athletes and coaches by their NF regardless if the team chooses a different accommodation on its own cost.</p> <p>The Austrian Volleyball Federation is going to send the respective invoice for participating NFs after the team registration. Teams are required to bring the transfer receipt to the preliminary inquiry. Organizer has the right to exclude teams from the tournament that has not paid the “unique fee”. Teams that are withdrawn within 10 days before the Preliminary Inquiry of their respective competition are also obliged to pay the unique fee.</p>
